About Spelman

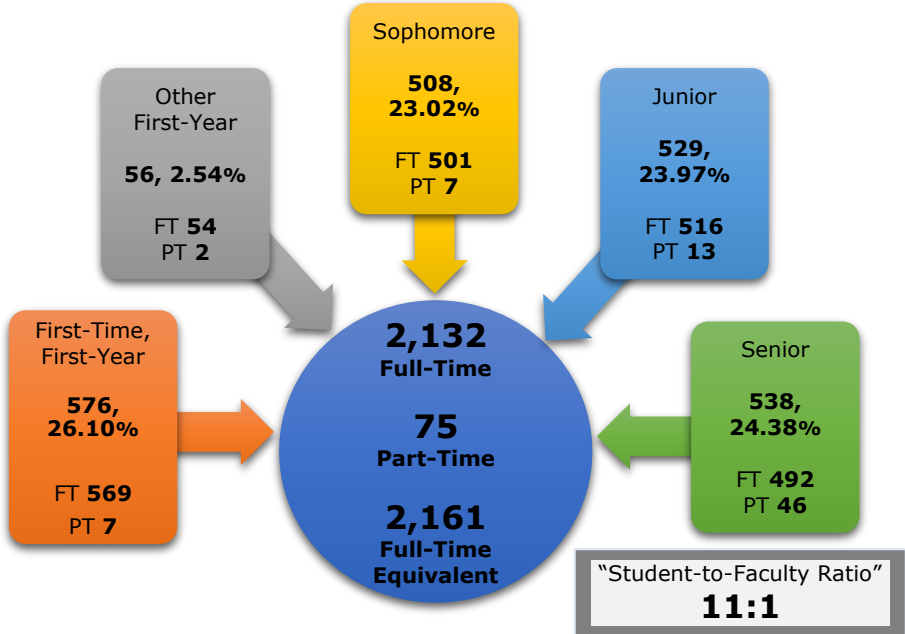

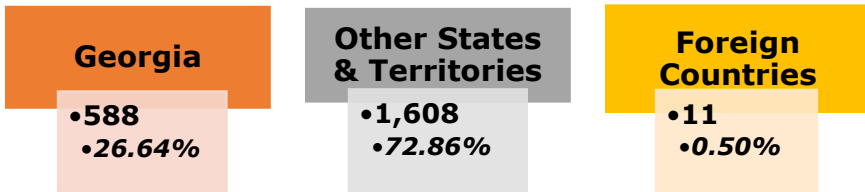

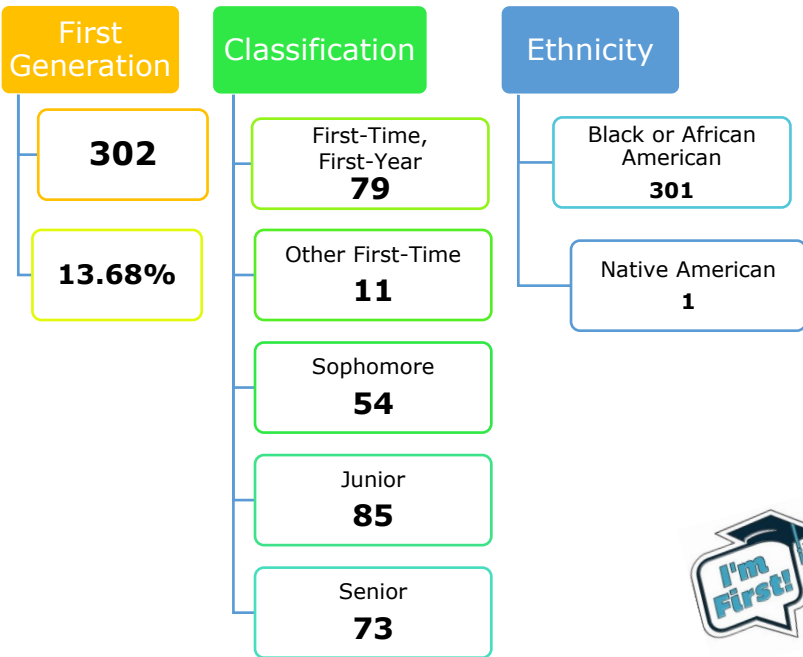
Fall 2020 Retention Rate – **89%**
