- 2.) Internal Spelman Application Deadline Date: The third Friday of October, by 4:00 p.m. (EST)
- 3.) Application must be submitted to: Dean Neely at <u>dneely@spelman.edu</u>
- 4.) Application and ALL supporting documentation must be submitted as a PDF.
- 5.) Application and all supporting documentation must be submitted as an attachment.
- 6.) Email subject line for applications must be entitled (all capitalized): UGA/SPELMAN FEEDER PROGRAM APPLICATION FOR: <u>INSERT NAME HERE</u>
- 7.) The signature on the application must be an authentic signature, not an electronic signature.
- 8.) It is recommended that the application is typed and not handwritten.

- 2.) When will I know if I've been nominated for the UGA/Spelman Feeder Program?
